LB 877, 908, 910

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Yes. I move to readvance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to readvance LB 877 from Select File to final Enrollment and Review. All those in favor say aye. Request for a machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Motion is the advancement of LB 877 from Select File to final Enrollment and Review. Please record your vote. If you wish to vote, please record your vote on the advancement of LB 877. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to readvance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced back to Enrollment and Review for review...for final review.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to return LB 877 to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: (Response inaudible.)

PRESIDENT: Motion is withdrawn. We next proceed to LB 908 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 908 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 908 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1489-90 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Next on Final Reading is LB 910.
