ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1529-30 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 973 passes with the emergency clause attached. May I please introduce some guests of Senator Lamb (sic). In the north balcony, we have 20 business educational students from Lincoln East High School, with their instructors. Would you please stand and be recognized.
