We will be spending the most of Monday morning on appropriation bills because we are running a little behind on those and, of course, Monday afternoon we will go to something else. SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move that we adjourn until nine, Monday, March 24th.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, you have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned. Thank you.
