SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Lundy, would you like to move the E & R amendments, please.

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. President, I move that the E & R amendments be approved.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are approved.
