

the Public Works Committee to do its best to come up with some language that is, in fact, not the product of the heat of floor discussion and this sort of joint brainstorming that we are having around the room right now. This is not deliberative lawmaking of informed public policy choices. I would ask us to narrow the issues and send this back to committee.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Landis proposal to return the bill to the Public Works Committee. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. 25 votes required, of course, for a successful adoption of this amendment. Please record your vote. Twenty seconds to record your vote. Ten seconds to record your vote. Five. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. With as many as there are that are just coming on the floor, I would ask that we have a call of the house and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the house is under call. All members of the Legislature at your station, please record your presence light. Put on your green light. Members outside the Chamber, please return to the Legislative Chamber, the house is under call. Senator Morehead. Thank you. Senator Smith, please. Senator McFarland, please record your presence. Senator Nichol, please. Senators Nichol, Chambers, Beyer and Vard Johnson, return to the Chamber, the house is under call. Senators Vard Johnson, Senator Bill Nichol, Senator Beyer, Chambers. Roll call vote has been requested. Senator Chambers, thank you. Senator Nichol and Senator Vard Johnson, please return to the Chamber. Senator Nichol, please. Sergeant-at-Arms will call Senator Nichol. Senator Landis says we will proceed. Roll call vote has been requested. May we please have silence in the Legislature so that the Clerk may hear your vote. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1688-89 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 28 nays, Mr. President, on
