

PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Members will please rise for the prayer. This morning our visiting Chaplain is the District Superintendent of the Lincoln District of the United Methodist Church. He comes to us as a guest of Senator Sieck. It is my privilege to present to you Reverend Albert Winseman.
