LB 1038, 1047, 1123

PRESIDENT: The rules are suspended, and the bill may be read. Members, please be in your seats for...take up Final Reading. LB 1038.

CLERK: (Read LB 1038 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1038 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Final Reading vote on 1038. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1729-30 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. We next move to LB 1047.

CLERK: (Read LB 1047 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1047 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1730 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 1047 is declared passed. The Chair would like to announce, on behalf of Senator Sieck, that he has guests in the north balcony. They are 26 fourth graders from St. Joseph's School in York, Nebraska, accompanied by their teacher. My personal guest, under the north balcony, is Mr. R.D. Makinster from Omaha. I'd like to have him introduced. If you would all stand, please, we'd like to recognize you and welcome you to the Legislature. Thank you. We proceed to Final Reading, LB 1123.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would move to return LB 1123 to Select File for purposes of striking the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Landis.
