

be an additional 21,000 added onto the appropriations bill?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: The way the claim has been presented to us as approved and recommended by the Attorney General's office, the funds would come out of the General Fund. Now, Senator Haberman, Senator Warner can, I think, more appropriately address the issue as to whether those funds should come out of the General Fund or should come out of the Probation Office's portion of the General Fund.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I am sorry, Senator Hoagland, but Senator Warner didn't do that. He suggested that I talk to you about this, and I am just trying to make a point that if the Probation Administration screwed up, and they are getting more money now than they ever have before, why shouldn't they have to take it out of their budget instead of coming back and have us tack on another \$21,000 for the General Fund, and the same way on the next claim for 12,000? Who screwed that one up? The Department of Education?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Well, why don't we let Senator Warner address the Appropriations Committee's normal approach in situations of this sort.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I have used up my time. I will wait until the bill has come before us.

PRESIDENT: Let's get the bill introduced if we may. Is there...all those in favor of suspending the rules for the introduction of the Appropriations Committee bill vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting now on the suspension if the rules in order to introduce an Appropriations Committee bill. Please record your vote on the motion to suspend the rules in order to introduce an Appropriations Committee bill. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to introduce the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is introduced.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill, 1259 by the Appropriations Committee. (Read for the first time by title. See page 1755-56 if the Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, I now have a motion from Senator Warner to suspend Rule 3, Section 4 to place LB 1258 directly on General File.
