SENATOR BAACK: Okay, I think I've pretty well explained the amendment now. I would, if there are no questions, I would just urge you to adopt the amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there anyone wishing to speak on the amendment, aye or nay? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Baack. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.
