LB 318, 318A, 813

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members, this bill was introduced by Senator Peterson and myself. It is Senator Peterson's priority bill. This amendment is a technical change in the date in which the next cosmetology license would be issued and inadvertently we had it for 1988. This would bring it back to 1986 when they would normally have to get relicensed anyway, so there was a drafting error and this would correct that error in the date. I'd ask support for the amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Wesely. There are no lights and this is the only amendment on LB 318. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, the amendment is adopted. Senator Lundy, to move the bill.

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. President, I move that we move LB 318 to E & R for final.
