SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move advancement of the bill. Just a point of clarification regarding the question that Senator Pappas asked. Most of these cities retain an attorney. Some of them have their own city attorneys, others contract for it. Also the League of Municipalities who supports this bill have legal counsels so I don't think that would be a problem. So with those words to you, I would move for the advancement of this bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. If you care to vote, please do so. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, how many are excused today?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Four.

SENATOR HEFNER: Four. I will ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Those unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Please return to your desks and record your presence so we can move on. We really need to get with it, ladies and gentlemen, please. Senator Hefner, you will accept call in votes, all right.

CLERK: Senator Hannibal voting yes. Senator Goll voting yes. Senator Chronister voting yes. Senator Barrett voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Do you have anything to put in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do.
