If not, all those in favor of that motion...Senator Chambers. I am sorry, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I just want to point out that ordinarily on a bill like this, there are things I would attempt such as my sports book betting but I am not going to do it, and I want to call your attention to the fact that I am leaving this terrible bill alone.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The question is, shall LB 1027 as amended be advanced? All those in favor will vote aye...say aye. Those opposed no. The ayes have it and the bill is advanced. We have one more, we have an A bill with that, is that correct, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, let's see, the A bill. I do have an amendment from Senator Vard Johnson to the A bill, LB 1027A, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Johnson, please.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I hope I can do this really quickly. This is the A bill to 1027. Because of the changes that have been made in 1027 with these amendments, there has to be an amendment to the A bill. There is an amendment on the desk. I would ask that you accept the amendment.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, the amendment to the A bill as explained by Senator Johnson. All those in favor of adopting that amendment will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. We are still under call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Johnson amendment.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The amendment is adopted. Now, on the bill, Senator Johnson, please.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I would move the bill by voice vote, please.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall LB 1027A as amended be advanced? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to read in?
