SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Withem, please.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I would call the question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is, shall debate cease? Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Debate has ceased. Senator DeCamp, did you wish to close on the bill?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, I do. Could we have a call of the house since I suspect we will need that for the vote anyway?

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 1 nay to go under call.
