SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Are we under call at this time or...

SENATOR CARSTEN: We are still on Final Reading. The call has never been raised. We are on Final Reading.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Well, I'd ask for everyone to check in, please, and then we'll proceed with a roll call, please.

SENATOR CARSTEN: A request for everybody to check in and a roll call vote has been requested. Please push your green button. Senator Labedz, would you push your button, please. Senator Nichol, Senator Landis, Senator Vickers, Senator Harris, please. Senator Hoagland, Senator Lowell Johnson. Senator Landis, Senator Hoagland. Everybody is here. Okay, everybody is here. You may proceed with a roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Began roll call vote.)

SENATOR CARSTEN: Excuse me, Mr. Clerk. We are voting, for those of you who came back in, on the motion to return LB 899 to Select File for a specific amendment. I'm sorry, Mr. Clerk, you may proceed.

CLERK: (Continued roll call vote as found on page 2062 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Motion fails. The bill is not returned. Do you have anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Well, Mr. President...

SENATOR CARSTEN: Shall we read the bill? Senator Johnson, Rod Johnson, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I mentioned in my opening on the motion to return the bill that if the amendment was not successful that the bill would be objectionable to a number of groups including the Seedsmen Association, so I would ask unanimous consent to pass over LB 899.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Request for unanimous consent to pass over
