SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, are we through with the 300 situation?

PRESIDENT: Yes.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the Enrollment and Review amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have some amendments that were filed last year. The first is Senator Higgins. Senator, I have a note you want to withdraw that amendment. Senator Higgins wishes to withdraw, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Those amendments are withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, I also have an amendment from Senator Hoagland that was filed last year. Senator, do you want to withdraw that amendment? Mr. President, the next amendment...
