LB 31A, 835A

CLERK: Mr. President, 31A again is on General File. The main bill is on Select. It is offered by Senator Warner. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Have E & R? We are on General File again. We are on General File. The Chair recognizes Senator Warner and may we have order please so we may hear (gavel) the Chairman of the Budget Committee.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, LB 31A is on General File. I would ask that it be advanced to Select File. I don't know that we'll use it. At one point there was the intent to use LB 31 for some telecommunications legislation. It needed an A bill in the event that time permits it to be done. I don't know that it will be done. LB 31 currently has an income tax on it. If it is used for that, it will make no difference. There is no intent other than to have that bill up with Select File in the event that the amendment of telecommunication becomes possible. We may never have time. So I just ask that the A bill be advanced and it would have to be properly amended in the event that it could be used for the purpose it was intended to be.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on this motion to advance the A bill from General File? I have lights on for Senators Landis and Nelson. All right. Is there discussion? If not, the motion then is to advance LB 31A from General File to Enrollment and Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote aye or nay on the motion to advance LB 31A to Enrollment and Review from General File. Please record your vote aye or nay. Please record your vote to the...have you all voted? CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 31A.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Next we move to 835A on Select File.

CLERK: Mr. President, 835A is on Select File. I have no amendments to the bill, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: (Microphone not turned on immediately.)
