PRESIDENT: The motion carries. We are under call. I assume we may take call ins. You may call in your vote to the Clerk if you did not have a chance to vote on the advancement of 600A.

CLERK: Senator Schmit voting yes. Senator Lamb voting yes. Senator Labedz voting no. Senator Barrett voting yes. Senator Abboud voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? You can still call in your vote to the Clerk, aye or nay, on the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Hannibal voting yes. Senator Scofield changing from yes to no, changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 600A advances. Next we go...while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 417 which was adopted today by the Legislature. We go to motions, 1230. The call of the house is raised. We go to motions, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might, right before that, some items for the record.

PRESIDENT: All right, matters for the record.

CLERK: Confirmation reports from the Business and Labor Committee and the Education Committee signed by the Chairs.

New resolutions, LR 424 from the Business and Labor Committee; LR 425 by Senator Rogers; LR 426 by Senator Vickers; Senator Barrett offers LR 427; LR 428 by Senators Barrett and Vickers; LR 429 by Senator Hefner; LR 430 by Senator Hefner; LR 431 by Senators Hefner and Conway; and LR 432 by Senator Rod Johnson.
