SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Smith, would you like to close on your resolution, please.

SENATOR SMITH: I would just simply like to thank Senator Chambers and Senator Rod Johnson for their support for this resolution. It is becoming an increasingly growing concern for us in the State of Nebraska. The idea of my resolution is to bring it to your attention, and I want to try to do some things in legislation that will simply enforce responsibility for...on behalf of these people from the contractors who bring them here and to try to alleviate the kinds of conditions that are developing. I ask for your support of the resolution. Thank you.
