PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. We proceed to LR 318CA.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LR 318CA on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LR 318 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Thirty affirmative votes are required, of course, for passage for later...have you all voted on the final passage of LR 318? Have you all voted? Record the vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2407-08 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 3 nays, 3 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the resolution is declared passed, sufficient to place it on the ballot. Matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, just that the bills that have been read on Final Reading this afternoon are now ready for your signature.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign engrossed LBs 835, 835A, 956, 997, 997A, 1001, 1001A, LB 1004, LB 1004A, 1124, 1124A, 1177, 1255, 1256 and engrossed LR 318. Mr. Speaker, do you have any words of comfort for the membership?
