PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 911 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 2431 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 10 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?
