CLERK: (Read LB 921 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 921 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2433 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members having voted in the affirmative, LB 921 is declared passed. Next is LB 926 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 926 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 926 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. You are now voting on Final Reading of LB 926. Please record your vote. Do you wish to record your vote? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2434 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
