AN ACT relating to cities and villages; to amend section 18-1712, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating to the sponsorship of the fire training school; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

That section 18-1712, Reissue Revised Statutes of Section 1. Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

18-1712. Any city or village in the State of Nebraska is hereby authorized and empowered to may pay from municipal funds the cost of training and the expenses of such members from each fire company as designated by its governing body to attend the fire training school, jointly sponsored by the State Board of Vocational Education, State Volunteer Firemen's Association, Nebraska State Volunteer Firefighter's Association, the State Fire Marshal, the Nebraska Forest Service-Fire Control, a division of the University of Nebraska Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources, and the Civil Defense Agency and held periodically at the state fire training school. Sec. 2. That original section 18-1712, Reissue Revised Statutes of

Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
