AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section 28-914, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to
loitering about jail; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 28-914, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:
28-914. (1) Any person who loiters about any jail a penal institution in this state and engages in an unauthorized conversation with or passes any unauthorized message or messages to any inmate of such jail institution, or fails or refuses to leave the immediate vicinity of any jail a penal institution when ordered to do so by any a peace officer or correctional official, commits the offense of loitering about jail a penal institution is a Class III

misdemeanor.

(3) For purposes of this section, penal institution includes a jail, prison, penitentiary, house of correction, or other place of penal detention.

Sec. 2. Original section 28-914, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
