SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Any closing? Closing has been waived. Question is the advancement of LB 4. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 4.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 4 is advanced. LB 5, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 5, Mr. President, offered by Senator Hall as Chair of the board. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5 of this year, referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. LB 5 would transfer 11 sections from Chapter 79 to Chapter 85. These deal again with the Nebraska Educational Finance Authority. I'd move advancement to E & R Initial of LB 5.
