CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Matzke's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Matzke amendment is adopted. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, thank you. I have hearing notices from the Executive Board, Education Committee, Urban Affairs Committee, and the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, all signed by their respective chairs. Business and Labor reports LB 334 to General File with amendments, signed by Senator Abboud. Revenue reports LR 3 to General File with amendments. That is signed by Senator Warner. General Affairs reports LB 72 indefinitely postponed, and that is signed by Senator Schellpeper. Natural Resources reports LB 94 to General File, LB 147 General File, LB 259 General File with amendments, LB 296 General File with amendments, signed by Senator Beutler as chair. A new bill, Mr. President. (Read LB 885 for the first time by title.) And, Mr. President, a confirmation report from the Natural Resources Committee. That is all that I have. (See pages 540-45 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, the next amendment to LB 20 is by Senator Beutler.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'd withdraw that amendment, Mr. Clerk.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Amendment is withdrawn. Anything else?

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to amend. (See AM0155 on page 545 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Chambers.
