PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. Is there any further discussion on the Maurstad amendment? Seeing none, Senator Maurstad, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Maurstad amendment to LB 144. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 16 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Maurstad amendment fails. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: I do, and I have other amendments, Madam President, but if I may. Government Committee reports LB 154 to General File with amendments, LB 166, LB 195, LB 205, all General File with amendments. Transportation Committee LB 37 General File with amendments, LB 253, LB 424 and Agriculture Committee reports LB 87 to General File, those all signed by respective Chairpersons. New A bill, LB 369A. (Read for the first time by title.) And I have two confirmation reports, one from the Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee, I'm sorry, I have a hearing notice from the Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee and gubernatorial appointment reports from Natural Resources and Government. And Senator Warner has amendments to be printed to LB 386. (See pages 608-18 of the Legislative Journal.)

Senator Maurstad would move to amend, Madam President, with AMO264. (Amendment appears on page 618 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.
