SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Pirsch. Any discussion on returning to Select File of LR 21? Seeing none, Senator Pirsch, would you like to close? She waives closing. The question is, shall LR 21CA be returned to Select File for amendment? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. It is returned to Select File. Senator Pirsch, on the amendment.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I would move the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Any discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, the question is, shall the amendment to LR 21CA be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I would move to advance LR 21 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LR 21 to E & R engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LR 1CA.

CLERK: Madam President, I have a unanimous consent request from Senator Landis to pass over LR 1CA until the end of Final Reading today. Read it at the end, is that right, Senator?

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Landis.
