Enrollment and Review reports LB 65, LB 83, LB 83A, LB 93, LB 119, LB 412, LB 501, LB 502 as correctly engrossed. New A bills. Senator Hall opened on the bill, I believe; when the Legislature recessed that day Senator Avery had pending an amendment that's found on page 727 of the Journal, Madam President.
