

language in front of you, but what it would do on page 1, line 12, it would strike "eight" and insert "twelve" and in line 16 it would strike "twelve" and insert "eighteen". On page 2, line 26, it would strike "six" and insert "ten" and on page 3, line 17, it would strike "twelve" and insert "eighteen", which is exactly like the chart indicates. One of the things that I should point out is that the figure most often compared is probably those on the constitutional amendment because that's what is used the most often is the constitutional amendment process. We've had very few petition drives over the last few years that have involved laws. But this amendment effectively puts it at, for a volunteer circulator, at 55,159 as compared to pre Dugan which was about 57,000. And what we're trying to do is change it here so that it more closely reflects the numbers that we had before which didn't happen in the committee amendment because they changed just the...they didn't change the percentages when they changed it from registered voters to voters voting in the last gubernatorial election and I hate to go on because I'm probably confusing you even more. But it's just like the chart shows on the bottom of the page changing the committee amendment now and the paid and volunteer numbers to this amendment for paid and volunteer numbers. Thank you very much.
