SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 48 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1050-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 48 passes with the emergency clause attached. LR 4CA.
