SENATOR CROSBY: The bill advances. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, I do. Your Committee on Government reports LB 375 to General File; LB 511 to General File; LB 609 to General File with amendments; LR 36CA as indefinitely postponed; LR 37CA, indefinitely postponed; LB 341, indefinitely postponed; LB 506, LB 664, LB 823, all indefinitely postponed.
