SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is the forty-sixth day of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, First Session, Thursday, March 16th. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Sheryl Tedder, of the Nazarene Central Church in Omaha.
