

merely cleans up and makes it clear that we're combining the two Cash Funds and if there's any money left over in the one Cash Fund, it's going to get poured over into the Department of Motor Vehicles' regular Cash Fund on July 1, 1995. I would tell you that if we don't do something, establishing at least some fee with the problem driver pointer system and when employers are accessed, they will be able to access it regardless of the fee, we'll just wind up digging ourselves in a hole later on down the line. This fee is not over and above any other fee that's charged. In fact, it's consistent with what we do charge insurance companies to check those records right now. So, with that, I would urge the adoption of the committee amendments and the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. There are no lights. Waiving on the committee adoption?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I would waive, please.

SENATOR LANDIS: Then let's move to a vote on the adoption of the committee amendments for LB 467. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Kristensen, on the bill itself.

Mr. President, I think that we've adequately described the bill through the committee amendment process but, again, I would just tell you that the bill does do four things. It merges the Cash Funds. It allows for the establishment of a fee for employers who are checking employees through the problem driver pointer system. It changes the terminology in our statute and cleans it up from calling them physical defects to using the word "impairment", and would allow those residents, who are out of the State of Nebraska and unable to return, an
