

closing. Those in favor of the committee amendments vote aye. Those opposed vote no. For those of you close to your desks, if you could cast your ballot. Perhaps Senator Schrock has a message or a signal he can give one of his colleagues. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you very much. Senator Matzke, on the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR MATZKE: Mr. President and members, I have nothing further to say. Unless there are questions about the bill, I would waive both opening and closing, and request that the bill be advanced.

SENATOR LANDIS: There are no lights. That constitutes the opening and the closing. Those in favor of the advancement of LB 350 cast your ballots for or against. Senator Beutler, let me give you notice that the Chair is going to entertain a motion to recess after LB 303, and not after 541. Those of you close to your desks, if you would cast a ballot, send a signal across the room, give a high sign. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the vote is 25 ayes, 0 nays to advance the bill to E & R Initial.

SENATOR LANDIS: The bill is advanced. The body should understand that they have moved or will have disposed of 23 bills in the space of about two and a half hours. With Senator Schimek's opening on LB 303, and for that reason, since we haven't had any call of the houses, we would like to be able to return some of that time you saved back to you for a more luxurious lunch hour. Mr. Clerk, would you tell us about LB 303?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 303 was introduced by Senators Schimek and Hartnett. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time January 10th, referred to Judiciary Committee. That committee reports the bill to General File with committee amendments.
