SPEAKER WITHEM: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We're very pleased today to have our chaplain for the day from Senator Vrtiska's district, pastor of the Methodist Church in Douglas and Burr, Nebraska. We have with us Michael Davis.

Attorney General's Opinion to Senator Hartnett (re. LB 753). Madam President, I have a series of resolutions ready for your signature. That's all that I have, this morning. PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 71, LR 72, LR 73, LR 74, LR 76, LR 77, LR 78 and LR 79. We turn now to General File and LB 752.
