SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I would move to advanced LB 274 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is readvanced. LR 24CA, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have...I had an amendment on the bill, Mr. President, but I understand the introducer would like to withdraw.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The introducer will withdraw it, yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing on the resolution.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay, if members would take their seats, the rest of the bills, at least at this point, do not have amendments on them. We will proceed with Final Reading. Mr. Clerk. For what purpose do you rise, Senator Hall?
