SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members, I support this. I just wanted to add, too, the fact that this allows the Secretary of State to go ahead and send this out. It's a matter of being time sensitive. There's about 10,000. I don't know whether Senator Warner said that, but there's 10,000 that need to be...have this sent back and it's comfortable for me to have this move ahead so that this can...this process can start and I simply want to add my support to that.
