(Re: LB 182A, LB 182, LB 452, LB 420, LB 411, LB 402, LB 366, LB 334, LB 305, LB 297, LB 288, LB 271, LB 270, LB 259, LB 222. And LR 24CA passed by the Legislature on Final Reading this morning has been presented to the Secretary of State. Mr. President, a new resolution, LR 81. (Read brief explanation.) That will be laid over. (See above items on pages 1312-13 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Item 9, General File. LB 178A, Senator Abboud is not present. Is there anybody authorized to carry the bill? LB 178 will stand as killed then. LB 377A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 377A, a bill introduced by Senator McKenzie. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator McKenzie. Is there anybody authorized to handle LB 377A? Senator McKenzie is on her way.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the body. LB 377A is introduced as the appropriations bill to follow LB 377. It allows for the appropriation of the necessary administrative funds through the mechanism in the bill, and that part does have to be an appropriation. Even though we have talked about in great length the transfer and that issue, this will follow the bill regardless of adoption of that particular aspect. With that, I would ask for the advancement of 377A.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You're welcome. No, I didn't speak.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Your light was on. I am sorry. Okay. Senator...anybody else to discuss the advancement of LB 377A? Senator McKenzie, closing? Closing is waived. The question is the advancement of LB 377A. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Members, we are voting on the advancement of LB 377A from General File to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: A call of the house.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
