SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Beutler. We are under call. We're still looking for Senator Lynch. And a roll call vote has been requested. Senator Beutler, we've been looking for Senator Lynch. We're informed by the Sergeant at Arms that he cannot be located at the moment. Proceed with the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taker. See pages 1329-30 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 20 nays on the advancement, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill does not advance. Call is raised. Mr. Clerk, LB 168. Like to do some items for the record, now would be an appropriate time.

CLERK: Mr. President, items. New resolution, LR 82. (Read.) Amendments to be printed, Senator Matzke to LB 172; Senator Coordsen to LB 37; and Senator Witek to LB 548. (See pages 1330-34 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your Committee on Natural Resources reports LB 100 to General File, and LB 480 as indefinitely postponed. Those signed by Senator Beutler as Chair. And I have an explanation of vote from Senator Pedersen. (See page 1334 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, LB 168 was originally introduced by Senator Jones and other members. (Read title.) The bill was referred to Government, advanced to General File. Committee amendments were offered on March 21, Mr. President. There were amendments to the committee amendments, one by Senator Bromm that was adopted. The bill was bracketed until Monday, March 27. I believe, Mr. President, consideration of the committee amendments is what's pending before the Legislature at this time.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay, the committee amendments are before the body on LB 168, they have not been adopted. Are there amendments pending to the committee amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I don't believe so, Mr. President. I think all the other amendments are to the bill itself.
