LB 178A, 189, 189A, 337A

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Schimek. Is there anyone authorized to take Senator Schimek's bill? Mr. Clerk, LB 178A.

CLERK: LB 178A by Senator Abboud.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Abboud. Mr. Clerk, LB 189A.

CLERK: LB 189A by Senator Crosby. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning, Mr. Speaker, again, and thank you very much. This is actually Senator Withem's bill, but it is my priority bill, and it is the companion bill to LB 189, which is still alive because we have amended part of it into another bill, but we still need the appropriations bill to go along with it to keep it legal. So, that's all I know about 189A, Senator Withem. I think the main point is so the 189A keeps up with 189, and it is clear...it is on Select or beyond.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Crosby. Any discussion on the bill? Seeing none, Senator Crosby, do you have closing?

SENATOR CROSBY: No.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Closing is waived. The question is the advancement of LB 189A. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 189A.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 337A.

CLERK: LB 337A by Senator Schimek. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, this A bill has some very minimal costs for printing of the brochures; \$300 from the General Fund for '95-96, and 4,800 for '96-97.
