SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Is there anyone else who would care to speak to the motion? Seeing none, Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hall. Mr. President, I would move to advance LR 6 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Record vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1456-57 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LR 6CA.

SENATOR HALL: LR 6CA is advanced. Anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Not at this time, Mr. President, thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Next item on the agenda, LB 37.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 37 (sic), the first item, E & R amendments, Senator Maurstad, if you will.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Maurstad, on the E & R amendments.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments for LB 37.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. Amendments are adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Coordsen would move to amend. Senator, I have AM886 in front of me, found on page 1056 of the Journal.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Coordsen, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Some of you may remember that when this bill was heard on General File I mentioned that given the attendance figure, I
