PRESIDENT ROBAK: Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Madam President, to cease debate.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Debate ceases. I recognize Senator Wickersham to close on his amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Madam President. I appreciate the time the body has taken to discuss the amendment. It may be necessary to clarify some of the provisions through additional amendments later on in the process, but I think we're starting in the right direction. We are starting to give some definition to how the fund will be used. I think it's appropriate for us to do that. I think the...to the extent we're directing that the fund be used for small businesses, I believe that is appropriate and hope that you will support the amendment and with that, Madam President, I will close.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. The question before you is the adoption of the Wickersham amendment to the Engel amendment to LB 425. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Wickersham amendment is adopted. I raise the call. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: I do have other amendments to the amendment, Madam President. Prior to consideration of those, however, Senator Lynch offers LB 148A. (Read by title for the first time.) Select File, E & R, I should say, reports LB 505, LB 509 and LB 344 to Select File. Health and Human Services reports LB 642 to General File, LB 455 General File with amendments. Amendments to be printed, Madam President, Senator Bohlke to LB 406, Senator Wesely to LB 837, Senator Janssen to LB 581, Senator Kristensen to LB 646.
