LB 19A, 19

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yes, just to remind the body what we did with LB 19. LB 19 originally was the bill calling for a separate juvenile judge for Douglas County in the separate juvenile court. Senator Lindsay actually was the...it was a Lindsay-Withem amendment that added to that the Lancaster district judge, I believe, the Sarpy district judge and maybe an additional separate juvenile judge for Douglas County. The amendment to the A bill will reflect those changes that were made when we amended LB 19. You'll still obviously have the choice on whether you vote for LB 19, when it is read on Final Reading. But this is needed at this point to make the A bill consistent with the amendments that were made to LB 19.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Withem. Senator Chambers, did you have anything more on your time or...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, that's the last time I'll ask Senator Withem to speak on anything pertaining to me, especially when he puts that caveat in, you still have the opportunity to decide whether you're going to vote for the bill. No, there is no choice (laugh) involved in this. This bill will be voted for affirmatively on Final Reading. Thank you. And with that little bit of lesson giving to the Speaker, I don't have anything further to say. Thank you, Madam President. And I hope you will vote to return this bill and add this amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay. No...any further discussion? Seeing none, I assume you waive closing, Senator Chambers? The question is the adoption or return to Select File, LB 19A for specific amendment. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill is returned. Now, Senator Chambers, are you....

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, I waive opening, closing and any comments by Senator Withem.

SENATOR CROSBY: (Laugh.) Any further discussion of LB 19A? Seeing none and he waived everything so we're ready to vote.
