

be recognized as legally valid in Nebraska. Section 4, an improper reference is changed. And Section 5 is new language, it substitutes the new language, deletes size, shape and color requirements for the permit, as well as language and marking specifications. In that place a permit is required to be constructed of plastic and the size, design, configuration, color and construction as specified in new federal regulation promulgated by the U.S. Department of Transportation. This information on marking permits are those permits are also to conform with what is set out in these regulations. Section 3 and 5 of the bill amends the bill's requirement that warning of a potential illegal use and penalties for improper use of the permits will be printed on the permit itself, replacing it with the requirements that the warning be printed on the application itself and a copy of the completed application with the warning be given to a handicapped individual receiving the permit. A new section is added for permits which removes the current (inaudible) issue of permits replacing with language which causes all permits to be issued after September 9, 1995, to expire on September 30 of the third year following issuance. A provision is also added which authorizes a 30-day grace period to renew the permit any application received within 30 days following the day of the permit expiration is deemed to have been filed prior to the day of the expiration. Also the current issuance of temporary permit for a 90-day period, one permit up for three renewals is substituted for a new six months temporary permit, one permit and a single six-month renewal. With that, I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendments.
