SENATOR HARTNETT: No, each...cities are treated...

SENATOR PIRSCH: Differently.

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...differently, yeah.

SENATOR PIRSCH: But these have certain qualifications that do not apply to metropolitan cities?

SENATOR HARTNETT: No. Metropolitan and primary cities are not included under that.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Did your committee discuss this?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Oh, whether we discussed it or not, I really kind of forget. It was...the problem came more with first class cities and second class city and villages.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I won't hold up the bill. I just wanted to see if that was discussed. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any further discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Hartnett waives off on closing. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments on LB 805. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the committee amendments to LB 805. Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments to LB 805, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The committee amendments are adopted. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Hartnett, on the bill.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Madam President, members of the body, I simply explained the bill. What it does is simply adds when a vacancy occurs in first and second class cities and villages on the Board of Adjustment, that they will appoint one person from this extraterritory area and that's all it does, is simply the next time there is a vacancy. So I would ask for the
