SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Would like to welcome very much our pastor of the day, our chaplain of the day is Pastor Alvin Trucano, United Methodist Church in Table Rock. And I just found out that extra special guest this morning because he and I attended the same high school back in Pisgah, Iowa, a number of years ago, so very pleased to see him here this morning.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much. Members, would you please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Quorum is present. Are there any corrections to the journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: New resolution, LR 96 by Senator Fisher asking the Legislature to support efforts of citizens who donated their time and energy towards problem solving in their communities. That will be laid over. Communication from the Arizona Legislature, be on file in the Clerk's Office. And reports from the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority, the State Highway Commission and the Department of Social Services, filed pursuant to statute, also will be on file in the Clerk's Office. SPEAKER WITHEM: General File, LB 889.

CLERK: LB 889, Mr. President, a bill introduced by Senator Wehrbein at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on April 13 of this year.
