PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Jeffrey Kunze, from St. John's Lutheran Church in Tecumseh, in Senator Vrtiska's district. Pastor Kunze.
