Beutler has pointed out through his amendments, but also for purposes of our budget down the line. And this is a big appropriation. It is a revenue expenditure, if you will, for purposes of the balancing of our budget down the line, and we are looking at approximately \$6 million that we are going to have to pick up, either through increasing taxes somewhere, or reducing A bills in other things or the budget overall down the line in order to balance it out. And I think folks need to be well aware of that and make good choices now on General File as opposed to waiting to the point in time where we deal with these issues after the budget has been passed across the board. And LB 106, I guess for me, is one that does not necessarily reflect good policy in terms of the...
