

Executive Director that the way things are going we are not real happy with the working relationship between Foster Care and Social Services. And I will give you, well, I will give you a specific example. Senator Crosby and I and Senator Day worked all summer on a task force on reviews, case reviews. Foster Care came in with their proposal that they wanted to do all the reviews. Social Services came in with a proposal. And we thought we had an agreement, Senator Day, would, would I think concur on this, we had an agreement that there was going to be type of a couple of pilot programs set up. We were going to test them from sharing of information and working together on some things. Then, all of a sudden, Foster Care goes to Senator Avery and they introduce their proposal, that would be do the total thing, without ever, ever trying to do what was compromised that was going to work out. Those are the end runs that drive a wedge between Social Services and Foster Care and this body. And I don't think we should reward that. I think we need to begin saying, at some point, we like what Foster Care is doing, we are supportive of Foster Care, but there are some problems at the top. And I probably...not probably, I will have, one of the amendments on Select File would be to take that 2,000 and it's not much, just try to make a point. And if I could do it on the Social Service Director, I would do that too, but that is not doable and, anyway, we are changing directors and it wouldn't be prudent. So I do have a concern on that portion because we have...we have some difficulties that need to be I think addressed at that point. With that, Madam President, I appreciate the time. That was the reason for the motion. I wanted to bring some things on to set the stage for what might be some...will be some amendments on Select File. I appreciate Senator Wehrbein's taking the time to go through some of those issues with me. I hope I didn't...I hope it was beneficial to those that care about some of those little areas, and with that, Madam President,...
