SENATOR CHAMBERS: If there were a requirement that a certain substance be tested for, is the state allowed to present a case showing a great unlikelihood of that substance being found here, therefore, such a test would not have to be undertaken?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I do not know the answer to that. That'd be a waiver I would assume and that would be the common sense way to approach it if it was my call, but I do not know the answer. I'm not really up on that...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...clean air,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...clean water details.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. And I just thought this would be an opportunity for me to get a little more information on this subject than I really have, but I say again I do intend to support the amendment and I may vote for the bill but I certainly won't vote against it.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Seeing no further lights, Senator Wehrbein, do you wish to close?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I think it's clarified. This committee amendment takes...makes...becomes the bill creating a cash fund for DEQ to more accurately account for the funds going into the air emissions quality fund, so I would urge your passage of the amendments.
